21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 4 is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 6-18-409. Free tutoring.

26 A school district shall provide free tutoring for a student in grades
27 ten (10) or eleven (11) who is enrolled as a student in that school district
28 and who scores less than nineteen (19) on the math portion of the ACT exam or
29 less than nineteen (19) on the English portion of the American College Test
