### Subtitle

15 *TO PROVIDE REMEDIAL TUTORING TO TENTH*  
16 *AND ELEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS WHO SCORE*  
17 *BELOW NINETEEN (19) ON THE AMERICAN*

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 4 is amended  
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 6-18-409. Remedial tutoring.

26 (a) A school district shall provide remedial tutoring for a student in  
27 grades ten (10) or eleven (11) who is enrolled as a student in that school  
28 district and who scores less than nineteen (19) on the math portion of the  
29 ACT exam or less than nineteen (19) on the English portion of the American  
30 College Test exam.

31 (b) The expenditure by a school district of its national school lunch  
32 student funding under § 6-20-2305(b)(4) for the purposes of providing  
33 remedial tutoring under this section shall be a permissible use of the  
34 funding under § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(C)(i).
