18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 52, Subchapter 1 is amended*
21 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

22 *14-52-113. Severance consideration for certain chiefs of police.*

23 *(a) A person employed as a chief of police of a city of the first*
24 *class or a city of the second class who is not covered by civil service or a*
25 *written employment contract shall be paid a severance consideration when:*

26 *(1) The person's employment as chief of police is involuntarily*
27 *terminated;*

28 *(2) The person resigns under threat of termination; or*

29 *(3) The person resigns at the request of the appointing*
30 *authority.*

31 *(b)(1) Severance consideration under this section shall be equal to*
32 *the person's monthly salary multiplied by the number of years of service as*
33 *chief of police of the municipality.*

34 *(2) Severance consideration under this section shall not exceed*
35 *fifty percent (50%) of the person's annual salary at the time of termination*
36 *or resignation of employment.*
