14 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING
15 TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CREDIT.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-702(a)(1)(B), concerning staff
22 development sessions, is amended to read as follows:

23 (B) Certified personnel may count up to two (2) days of
24 ~~five and one half (5 1/2)~~ six (6) hours each of attendance at instructional
25 professional development sessions conducted by bona fide professional
26 organizations toward fulfillment of the ~~five (5)~~ ten (10) days of staff
27 development required by the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public
28 Schools, provided the sessions have been certified by the Department of
29 Education.
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31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-705 is amended to read as follows:

32 6-17-705. Professional development credit.

33 (a) Up to twelve (12) hours of professional development credit may be
34 earned by certified personnel for time required at the beginning of each
35 school year to plan and prepare a curriculum and other instructional material
36 for their assigned classes if the time is:



1 (1) Spent in their classrooms, offices, or media centers at the
2 public school; and

3 (2) Prior to the first student-teacher interaction day of the
4 school year, but no school district shall require certified personnel to work
5 additional days that are not included in their contracts unless the certified
6 personnel are paid their daily rate of pay.

7 (b) Certified personnel shall earn one (1) hour of professional
8 development credit for each hour of planning and preparation that meets the
9 requirements of subsection (a) of this section.

10 (c) Certified personnel may earn up to eighteen (18) hours of online
11 professional development credit.

12 (d)(1) If catastrophic illness of a teacher or a teacher's immediate
13 family under § 6-17-1202 prevents a teacher from obtaining the required
14 professional development hours, the teacher shall be allowed to make up the
15 hours missed during the:

16 (A) Remainder of the current school year; or

17 (B) Succeeding school year.

18 (2) The teacher may earn the professional development hours
19 through online professional development.

20 ~~(e)~~(e) The State Board of Education shall promulgate the rules
21 necessary for the proper implementation of this section.
