17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 13, Subchapter 1 is amended
20 to add additional sections to read as follows:

21 12-13-117. Modifications of fire prevention code.

22 When there are practical difficulties involved in carrying out the
23 provisions of the "Arkansas Fire Prevention Code", an officer may grant
24 modifications for individual cases if:

25 (1) The officer finds that a special individual reason makes
26 strict compliance with the "Arkansas Fire Prevention Code" impractical; and

27 (2) The modification complies with the intent and purpose of the
28 "Arkansas Fire Prevention Code".

30 12-13-118. Certain construction.

31 (a) If a portion of a facility or building is more than four hundred
32 feet (400') from a hydrant on a fire apparatus access road, as measured by an
33 approved route around the exterior of the facility or building, on-site fire
34 hydrants and mains shall be provided where required by an officer.
