BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-309(b), concerning the requirement for certification of teachers, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(l) If this requirement imposes an undue hardship on a school district, the district may apply to the State Board of Education for a waiver.
(2) The state board shall develop rules and regulations for granting a waiver.
(3) Any school district that obtains a waiver shall send written notice of the assignment to the parent or guardian of each student in the classroom no later than the thirtieth school day after the date of the assignment.
(4) The state board may waive or modify the requirement that an applicant seeking licensure as a special education teacher complete an additional performance-based program of study if the applicant is:
(A) Licensed in another state with a special education
license or endorsement; and

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(B) Has taught special education students for not less than five (5) years.
