19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(A), concerning funding for
22 national school lunch students, is amended to read as follows:

23 (4)(A) ~~For school years 2005-2006 and 2006-2007, national~~
24 National school lunch student funding for each identified national school
25 lunch student shall be as follows:

26 (i) For school districts in which ninety percent
27 (90%) or greater of the previous school year's enrolled students are national
28 school lunch students, funding shall be ~~one thousand four hundred forty~~
29 ~~dollars (\$1,440)~~ one thousand four hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$1,488);

30 (ii) For school districts in which at least eighty
31 percent (80%) but less than ninety percent (90%) of the previous school
32 year's enrolled students are national school lunch students, funding shall be
33 one thousand two hundred thirty-two dollars (\$1,232);

34 (iii) For school districts in which at least seventy
35 percent (70%) but less than ~~ninety percent (90%)~~ eighty percent (80%) of the
36 previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch students,



1 funding shall be ~~nine hundred sixty dollars (\$960)~~ nine hundred ninety-two
2 dollars (\$992); and

3 (iv) For school districts in which at least sixty
4 percent (60%) but less than seventy percent (70%) of the previous school
5 year's enrolled students are national school lunch students, funding shall be
6 seven hundred thirty-six dollars (\$736); and

7 ~~(iii)~~(v) For school districts in which less than ~~seventy percent~~
8 ~~(70%)~~ sixty percent (60%) of the previous school year's enrolled students are
9 national school lunch students, funding shall be ~~four hundred eighty dollars~~
