## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL LEVELS OF CATEGORICAL FUNDING FOR NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH STUDENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL LEVELS OF CATEGORICAL FUNDING FOR NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH STUDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2305(b)(4)(A), concerning funding for national school lunch students, is amended to read as follows:
(4) (A) For school years 2005-2006 and 2006-2007, national

National school lunch student funding for each identified national school lunch student shall be as follows:
(i) For school districts in which ninety percent (90\%) or greater of the previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch students, funding shall be one thousand four hundred forty dollars $(\$ 1,440)$ one thousand four hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$1,488);
(ii) For school districts in which at least eighty percent ( $80 \%$ ) but less than ninety percent $(90 \%$ ) of the previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch students, funding shall be one thousand two hundred thirty-two dollars (\$1,232);
(iii) For school districts in which at least seventy percent ( $70 \%$ ) but less than ninety percent ( $90 \%$ ) eighty percent ( $80 \%$ ) of the previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch students,
funding shall be mine hundred sixty dollars (\$960) nine hundred ninety-two dollars (\$992); and
(iv) For school districts in which at least sixty percent (60\%) but less than seventy percent (70\%) of the previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch students, funding shall be seven hundred thirty-six dollars (\$736); and
(iii)(v) For school districts in which less than seventy percent $(70 \%)$ sixty percent (60\%) of the previous school year's enrolled students are national school lunch students, funding shall be four hundred eighty dollars (\$480) four hundred ninety-six dollars (\$496).
