## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT PHYSICIANS RECEIVE FULL REIMBURSEMENT FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES PERFORMED BY A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT UNDER THE PHYSICIAN'S SUPERVISION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT PHYSICIANS RECEIVE
FULL REIMBURSEMENT FOR HEALTH CARE
SERVICES PERFORMED BY A PHYSICIAN
ASSISTANT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 79, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

23-79-154. Reimbursement for physician assistant services.
(a) As used in this section, "health plan" means any group, blanket,
or individual accident and health insurance policy, contract, or plan issued in this state by an insurance company, hospital medical service corporation, or health maintenance organization, provided that nothing in this subchapter shall apply to accident only, specified disease, hospital indemnity, medicare supplement, long-term care, disability income, or other limited benefit health insurance policies
(b) A health plan shall not refuse to reimburse a physician at the full rate for health care services provided by a physician assistant if the practice complies with the laws of this state.
(c) A health plan shall not impose a practice or supervision
restriction on a physician assistant which is inconsistent with or more restrictive than the restriction already imposed by the laws of this state.
