21	(a)(l) Within fifteen (15) days after the end of each calendar

24	during the previous calendar quarter.	
25	(2)(A) A registered lobbyist	who lobbies members of the General
26	6 Assembly shall file a monthly lobbyist ac	civity report, signed and sworn to,
27	7 for any month in which the General Assemb	ly is in session. A quarterly report
28	8 is not required if the registered lobbyis	has filed monthly lobbyist
29	9 activity reports for each month of the ca	Lendar quarter.
30	0 (B) The monthly lobbyi	st activity report shall be filed
31	l within ten (10) days after the end of eac	n month.
32	(b) Lobbyist activity reports shall be open to public inspection.	
33	(c) When filing any report required by this section, a lobbyist shall

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7	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-8-604 is amended to read as follows:	
8	21-8-604. Activity reports - Required contents.	
9	(a) The lobbyist activity reports shall be signed and sworn to by the	
10	registered lobbyist.	
11	(b) The reports shall contain:	
12	(1)(A) The total of all expenditures made or incurred by the	
13	registered lobbyist or on behalf of the registered lobbyist by his or her	
14	employer or any officer, employee, or agent during the preceding period.	
15	(B) These totals shall be itemized according to financial	
16	category and employers and clients, including food and refreshments,	
17	entertainment, living accommodations, advertising, printing, postage, travel	
18	telephone, and other expenses or services.	
19	(C) Registered lobbyists shall not be required to report	
20	office expenses other than office expenses specifically required to be	
21	reported under this section.	
22	(D) Registered lobbyists are not required to report	
23	unreimbursed personal living and travel expenses not incurred directly for	
24	lobbying;	
25	(2)(A) An itemized listing of each:	
26	(i) Gift Anything of pecuniary value given to a	
27	public servant or on behalf of the public servant;	
28	(ii) Payment for food, lodging, or travel in excess	
29	of forty dollars (\$40.00) on behalf of a public servant; and	
30	(iii) Any other item paid or given to a public	
31	servant or on behalf of the public servant, except for campaign	
32	contributions, having a value in excess of forty dollars (\$40.00) unless	
33	consideration of equal or greater value has been given therefor. If the	
34	person receiving or to be benefiting by the item is a public employee, the	
35	person's governmental body shall be identified.	
36	(B) Each item shall be identified by date, amount paid or	

1	value, and the name of the individual receiving or to be benefited by the	
2	item, and a description of the item.	
3	(C) In the case of special events, including parties,	
4	dinners, athletic events, entertainment, and other functions, expenses need	
5	not be allocated by individuals. The information reported for a special ever	
6	shall include:	
7	(i) The date of the event;	
8	(ii) The name of the event;	
9	(iii) The location of the event;	
10	(iv) The name of the governmental body or group of	
11	public servants invited;	
12	(v) The exact amount paid by the lobbyist toward the	
13	total expenditure; and	
14	(vi) The name of the lobbyist's employer or client	
15	making the expenditure and the names of all other lobbyists sharing in the	
16	cost of the payment;	
17	(3) A detailed statement of any money loaned or promised or lin	
18	of credit established to a public servant or to anyone on behalf of the	
19	public servant in excess of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per individual.	
20	Money loaned or a line of credit established that is issued in the ordinary	
21	course of business by a financial institution or a person who regularly and	
22	customarily extends credit shall not be required to be disclosed; and	
23	(4) A statement detailing the direct business association or	
24	partnership with any public servant before whom the lobbyist may engage in	
25	lobbying.	
26	(c) Whenever the name of a public servant will appear in an activity	
27	report of a lobbyist, the lobbyist shall notify the public servant and	
28	provide him or her the information being reported. The lobbyist shall mail or	
29	deliver the notification to the public servant not later than seven (7)	
30	working days prior to the date for filing the activity report.	
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
