24	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 6-17-204 is amended	to read as follows:

26	(a) The personne	el policies of all school distri	cts shall be considered
27	to be incorporated as	terms of the certified personnel	contracts and shall be
28	binding upon the certi	fied personnel and the district.

10	(3) All changes or additions to the personnel policies or new
11	personnel policies shall be made in accordance with this subchapter.
12	$(c)(1)(\Lambda)$ A district may adopt a uniform policy, in accordance with
13	this subchapter, limiting the number of past years' experience for which all
14	newly employed certified personnel will receive credit on the salary
15	schedule.
16	(B) The policy shall be written so that a prospective
17	certified employee can determine his or her placement on the salary schedule
18	$\frac{(2)(c)(1)}{2}$ A school district shall adopt, in accordance with this
19	subchapter, a supplement to the salary schedule for those certified staff
20	employed longer than the period covered by the salary schedule and for duties
21	in addition to certified employees' regular teaching assignments.
22	(3)(2) Compensation policies approved by the personnel policy
23	committee shall not apply to the chief administrator who is charged with
24	administration of salary policy for all employees.
25	$\frac{(4)}{(3)}$ No certified person may waive payment according to the
26	salary schedule.
27	(d) Under the provisions of The Educator's Compensation Act of 2001,
28	$6-17-2101$ et seq., \S $6-5-307(a)$, and \S $6-20-412$, no school district shall be
29	prohibited from paying certified staff additional salary increases as a
30	supplement to the salary schedule even though the certified staff is not
31	employed an additional time period longer than the period covered by the
32	salary schedule or required to perform duties in addition to the certified
33	employees' regular teaching assignments.
34	(d) Any changes or additions to the personnel policies that would
35	result in a reduction in salary or a reduction of any increase in salary to
36	which the school district has committed shall take effect only upon

1	compliance with the provisions of this section and under the Teacher Fair		
2	Dismissal Act of 1983, § 6-17-1501 et seq.		
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5	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-620(4)(C), concerning contracts for		
6	public school employees, is amended to read as follows:		
7	(C)(i)(a) Contracts issued to existing licensed personnel		
8	of the school district for the next school year shall be issued to all		
9	existing licensed personnel at the same time.		
10	(b) Contracts issued to newly employed licensed		
11	personnel for the next school year shall be issued after contracts are issue		
12	under subdivision (4)(C)(i)(a) of this section.		
13	(ii) A contract is considered issued when the		
14	contract is:		
15	(a) Made pursuant to Arkansas law;		
16	(b) Signed by the president and secretary of		
17	the school district board of directors; and		
18	(c) Presented to the licensed employee for his		
19	or her signature.		
20	$\frac{(G)}{(D)}$ The issuing of annual contracts to personnel other		
21	than substitute teachers employed on a daily basis and teachers shall be in		
22	writing and shall recite the duration of employment, specific duties, and		
23	annual salary;		
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
