## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE INVESTIGATORS OF THE CRIMES  
AGAINST CHILDREN DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO MAKE ARRESTS FOR  
VIOLATIONS OF THE LAWS OF THIS STATE; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AUTHORIZE INVESTIGATORS OF THE CRIMES  
AGAINST CHILDREN DIVISION OF THE  
DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO  
MAKE ARRESTS FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE LAWS  
OF THIS STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend provisions of the  
Arkansas Code to authorize investigators of the Crimes Against Children  
Division of the Department of Arkansas State Police to make arrests for  
violations of the laws of this state.
