AN ACT TO CREATE THE PROFESSIONAL
17 *LICENSURE STANDARDS BOARD.*

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-402 is amended to read as follows:

23 6-17-402. Rules and regulations.

24 (a) As used in this section, "certified teaching license" means the

25 license of a licensed classroom teacher, an administrator, a guidance

26 counselor, or a librarian issued by the State Board of Education.

27 ~~(a)(1)~~(b)(1) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules and

28 regulations for the issuance, licensure, relicensure, and continuance of

29 licensure of teachers in the public schools of this state.

30 (2)(A) In addition to other requirements, any person applying

31 for initial licensure as a teacher or administrator in the public schools or

32 a licensed teacher or administrator applying for a license in an additional

33 area shall take and complete a test recognized by the National Council for

34 Accreditation of Teacher Education and approved by the ~~board~~ State Board of

35 Education, and submit the scores to the Department of Education.

36 ~~(b)~~(B) No applicant for initial licensure or licensure in an



1 additional area shall receive a license after July 1, 2007, unless the
2 applicant scores at or above the minimum level set by the ~~board~~ State Board
3 of Education that are consistent with the recommendations of the Professional
4 Licensure Standards Board.

5 ~~(e)~~(C) All colleges and universities in this state shall report the
6 results of the examinations to the department upon request.

7 ~~(d)~~(c) The ~~state board~~ State Board of Education shall not delegate to
8 any college or university any of the ~~state board's~~ State Board of Education's
9 powers or duties pertaining to the issuance, licensure, relicensure, and
10 continuance of licensure of teachers in public schools in this state.

11 ~~(e)~~(d) ~~The state board~~ State Board of Education shall waive the
12 examination requirements under subsection ~~(a)~~(b) of this section for
13 individuals applying for licensure in Arkansas who have a valid out-of-state
14 teaching license and three (3) years' documented teaching experience as
15 required by the rules ~~and regulations~~ promulgated by the ~~state board~~ State
16 Board of Education.

17 ~~(f)~~ For purposes of this section, ~~"certified teaching license"~~
18 ~~includes that license of a licensed classroom teacher, administrator,~~

30 ~~(c) Each appointed Professional Education, Development, Licensure, and~~
31 ~~Assessment Board member shall be a resident of the State of Arkansas at the~~
32 ~~time of appointment and throughout his or her term.~~

33 ~~(d)(1) Each entity shall submit its list under subsection (b) of this~~
34 ~~section before July 1, 2003.~~

35 ~~(2) The State Board of Education shall make the appointments~~
36 ~~before August 1, 2003.~~

1 ~~(e) The Commissioner of Education shall call the first meeting no~~
2 ~~later than September 1, 2003.~~

3 ~~(f)(1) At the first meeting of the Professional Education,~~
4 ~~Development, Licensure, and Assessment Board, the members appointed by the~~
5 ~~State Board of Education shall draw lots to determine the terms of each~~
6 ~~member so that the terms of six (6) members shall expire in two (2) years and~~
7 ~~the terms of six (6) members shall expire in three (3) years.~~

9 ~~(7) Review, evaluate, and recommend requirements for license~~
10 ~~reciprocity;~~

11 ~~(8) Review, evaluate, and recommend requirements for adding~~
12 ~~licensure areas and endorsements to an existing valid license;~~

13 ~~(9) Consult with groups whose work may be affected by the~~
14 ~~Professional Education, Development, Licensure, and Assessment Board's~~
15 ~~recommendations;~~

16 ~~(10) Request and review reports from the department concerning~~
17 ~~licensed personnel and existing or potential shortage areas;~~

18 ~~(11) Hold public hearings, along with department staff, prior to~~
19 ~~submitting recommendations concerning professional education, development,~~
20 ~~licensure, and assessment to the State Board of Education for approval; and~~

21 ~~(12) Establish subcommittees as necessary to research the trends~~
22 ~~and impact of issues submitted to the Professional Education, Development,~~
23 ~~Licensure, and Assessment Board for consideration.~~

24 ~~(k) The commissioner may present to the State Board of Education as an~~
25 ~~agenda item any measure that the Professional Education, Development,~~

2 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 4 is amended
3 to add an additional section to read as follows:

4 6-17-422. Professional Licensure Standards Board.

5 (a) There is established the Professional Licensure Standards Board.

6 (b) The Professional Licensure Standards Board shall consist of
7 fifteen (15) members appointed by the State Board of Education as follows:

8 (1) The Commissioner of Education, or his or her designee, who
9 shall serve as a nonvoting member and chair;

10 (2)(A) Four (4) public school classroom teachers with a valid
11 Arkansas teaching license who are recommended by the Arkansas Education
12 Association.

13 (B) The four (4) public school classroom teachers shall
14 represent the four (4) congressional districts in Arkansas and include
15 classroom teachers who are licensed and teach at:

16 (i) A licensure level of prekindergarten through
17 grade four (PreK-4);

18 (ii) A licensure level of grades four through eight
19 (4-8);

20 (iii) A licensure level of grades seven through
21 twelve (7-12); and

22 (iv) Any licensure level to serve in one (1) at-
23 large position;

24 (3) Four (4) persons with a valid Arkansas teaching and
25 administrator's license who represent the four (4) congressional districts in
26 Arkansas and are:

27 (A) Recommended by the Arkansas Association of Educational
28 Administrators; and

29 (B) One (1) of whom shall hold a P-8 building level leader
30 license and serve as a middle-level building leader;

31 (C) Two (2) of whom shall be public school superintendents
32 with a valid Arkansas teaching and administrator's license recommended by the
33 Arkansas Association of School Administrators; and

34 (D) One (1) public school administrator with a valid
35 Arkansas teaching and administrator's license recommended by the Arkansas
36 Association of School Personnel Administrators;

1 (4) One (1) nonvoting representative designated by the
2 Department of Education from its offices of licensure and teacher quality
3 recommended by the commissioner;

4 (5)(A) Three (3) deans of education from Arkansas institutions
5 of higher education recommended by the Arkansas Association of Colleges for
6 Teacher Education.

7 (B)(i) One (1) dean shall be from a private institution of
8 higher education;

9 (ii) One (1) dean shall be from a public institution
10 of higher education; and

11 (iii) One (1) of whom shall have knowledge of
12 licensure issues;

13 (6) One (1) coordinator of educational leadership recommended by
14 the Arkansas Professors of Educational Administration; and

15 (7) One (1) curriculum program administrator recommended by the
16 Arkansas Association of Supervision and Curriculum Development.

17 (c)(1) The State Board of Education shall consider all recommendations
18 under subsection (b) of this section submitted to the secretary of the State
19 Board of Education by June 30, 2007 for the initial board, and by June 30 of
20 each year in which the term of a Professional Licensure Standards Board
21 member expires.

22 (2) If a recommendation for a person qualified to fill a
23 position on the Professional Licensure Standards Board is not received by the
24 deadline, the State Board of Education may appoint any qualified person to
25 fill the position.

26 (d)(1)(A) Each member of the Professional Licensure Standards Board
27 shall serve a term of three (3) years.

28 (B) The initial members shall draw lots for staggered
29 terms.

30 (2) The State Board of Education shall appoint any qualified
31 person to fill a position that is vacated before the expiration of a member's
32 term.

33 (e)(1) The appointed members of the Professional Licensure Standards
34 Board shall be residents of this state at the time of appointment and
35 throughout their terms.

36 (2) The Commissioner of Education or his or her designee shall

1 call an organizational meeting within twenty (20) calendar days after the
2 State Board of Education has made all necessary appointments.

3 (f)(1) The Professional Licensure Standards Board shall meet at times
4 and places the chair deems necessary, but no meetings shall be held outside
5 of this state.

6 (2) A majority of the members of the Professional Licensure
7 Standards Board shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of transacting
8 business.

9 (3) All action of the Professional Licensure Standards Board
10 shall be by a majority vote of the full membership of the Professional
11 Licensure Standards Board.

12 (g)(1) Members of the Professional Licensure Standards Board shall
13 serve without pay.

14 (2) Members of the Professional Licensure Standards Board may
15 receive expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-902, to be paid by
16 the Department of Education to the extent money is available for that
17 purpose.

18 (h) The Professional Licensure Standards Board shall:

19 (1) Develop and recommend for adoption to the State Board of
20 Education *minimum* college level preparatory and grade point average
21 requirements for all teachers applying for initial licensure or *additional*
22 *licensure* after July 1, 2007, that shall include *minimum* requirements for:

23 (A) Course of study;

24 (B) Program approval;

25 (C) Range of approved hours; and

26 (D) In-class teaching internships or practice teaching
27 hours;

28 (2)(A) With the assistance of the Department of Education and
29 the Department of Higher Education, review the audits of the teacher
30 education programs offered by all institutions of higher education in the
31 state to determine if the institutions' teacher education programs and
32 courses of study are aligned as necessary to allow graduates of the teacher
33 education program to become licensed under this act and the rules set by the
34 State Board of Education.

35 (B)(i)(a) To ensure *alignment with standards* in university
36 course syllabi for licensure, the Department of Education shall conduct

1 audits of licensure programs of study at all Arkansas institutions of higher
2 education.

3 (b) The audits shall use state standards or national
4 standards for licensure programs, or a combination of both.

5 (ii) The audits shall be conducted on a five-year
6 cycle beginning on July 1, 2007 and provided to the Professional Licensure
7 Standards Board.

8 (iii)(a) Institutions of higher education that do
9 not comply with the department's audit findings and recommendations shall
10 have one (1) semester to bring programs into compliance with the audit
11 recommendations and submit documentation of compliance to the Professional
12 Licensure Standards Board.

13 (b) If the institution of higher education
14 does not bring its program into compliance with audit recommendations, the
15 Professional Licensure Standards Board shall submit a recommendation to the
16 State Board of Education for discontinuance of the authority of the
17 institution to offer the licensure program; and

18 (3)(A) Establish a code of ethics for administrators and
19 teachers in educational environments for students in prekindergarten through
20 grade twelve (PreK-12).

21 (B) Upon the approval of the code of ethics, procedures,
22 and recommendations for enforcement required by § 6-17-422(g)(3), the valid
23 Arkansas teaching license of any person shall be subject to the conditions,
24 requirements, and mandates of the code of ethics, procedures, and
25 recommendations for enforcement.

26 (C)(i) The Professional Licensure Standards Board may
27 recommend to the State Board of Education and the State Board of Education
28 may approve the monetary fees to be paid by a person for the issuance,
29 reissuance, fine, or penalty associated with the process, procedures, or
30 enforcement of requirements necessary to issue or maintain an Arkansas
31 teaching license.

32 (ii) Under no circumstances shall any one (1)
33 specific fee or fine exceed one hundred dollars (\$100).

34 (iii) Revenue collected by the State Board of
35 Education from the fees and fines under this subdivision (g)(3)(C) shall be
36 used for the operation of the Professional Licensure Standards Board.

1 (D) The Professional Licensure Standards Board may:

2 (i) Establish procedures for receiving, considering,
3 and investigating complaints referred by the Department of Education, a
4 public school district, or a public school superintendent regarding the
5 unethical behavior of licensed school personnel;

6 (ii) Make recommendations for enforcement; and

7 (iii) Establish an ethics subcommittee of the
8 Professional Licensure Standards Board with equal representation of public
9 school teachers and administrators as well as one member from any other
10 category of representation on the Professional Licensure Standards Board.

11
12 SECTION 4. NOT TO BE CODIFIED. By July 1, 2008, the Professional
13 Licensure Standards Board shall submit to the State Board of Education for
14 approval the code of ethics, procedures, and recommendations for enforcement
15 required by § 6-17-422(g)(3).
