## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW CITIES TO DISPOSE OF OBSOLETE PROPERTY IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ALLOW CITIES TO DISPOSE OF OBSOLETE PROPERTY IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-58-306, concerning disposal of municipal supplies, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(c)(1) If an item of personal property belonging to a municipality becomes obsolete or is no longer used by a municipality, it may be:
(A) Sold at public auction;
(B) Sent to the Marketing and Redistribution Section of the Office of State Procurement of the Department of Finance and Administration; or
(C) Transferred to another governmental entity within the
state.
(2) If an item is not disposed of under subsection (c) of this section, the item may be disposed of in the landfill used by the municipality if the mayor or his or her authorized representative certifies in writing and the governing body of the municipality approves that it has:
(A) Been rendered worthless by damage or prolonged use; or
(B)(i) Only residual value; and
(ii) Been through public auction and not sold.
