22	WHEREAS, the Honorable Circuit Judge John Samuel Patterson was born in
23	Clarksville, Arkansas, on December 7, 1945, to Edward Hall and Gladys Thomson
24	Patterson; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson attended Clarksville public schools and
27	graduated from high school in May 1963; attended the University of Arkansas
28	at Fayetteville for his undergraduate degree and his law degree, graduating
29	in 1967 and 1970 respectively; while a college student was a member of Phi
30	Delta Theta fraternity; and while a law student was a member of Phi Alpha
31	Delta legal fraternity; and

33	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson was admitted to practice law in Arkansas in
34	1970; joined his father Edward H. Patterson in the practice of law in the
35	Patterson and Patterson firm from 1970 until 1982; held the position of
36	Deputy Prosecuting Attorney in Johnson County from 1971 until 1976; and held



1	the position of Clarksville Municipal Judge from 1976 until 1982; and

3	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson was elected circuit judge in 1982, serving
4	Franklin, Johnson, and Pope Counties, and retired in 2007; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson is a Rotarian and a 32nd Degree Mason; a
7	Johnson Regional Hospital Board member; a Johnson County Co-Op Board member;
8	a member of the Johnson County Cattlemen's Association; a member of the
9	Arkansas Cattlemen's Association; a member of the American Simmental
10	Association; and a member and deacon of First Presbyterian Church in
11	Clarksville, Arkansas; and

13	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson is a member of the American Bar Association;
14	and a member of the Arkansas Bar Association, having served on the House of
15	Delegates, the probate law committee, and the family law committee; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson has served with distinction as an attorney and
18	a judge during his career and is admired by attorneys and litigants alike;
19	and has served his community and the State of Arkansas with tireless
20	dedication; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, Judge Patterson is married to Edna Elkins Patterson, with whom
23	he has two (2) daughters, Page Patterson Hardin, and her husband Scott, and
24	Penny Patterson Coffman, and her husband Chad; and three (3) grandchildren,
25	Abigail Coffman, Regan Coffman, and Graham Hardin; and

27	WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Eighty-Sixth General
28	Assembly commends Judge Patterson on his long and distinguished service as a
29	circuit judge and wishes him well upon his retirement,
