21 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Legislative Research was established by the  
22 General Assembly to assist the members of the General Assembly in the  
23 performance of their official duties; and

25 WHEREAS, electronically delivered messages are commonly acknowledged to  
26 be faster than United States Postal Service mail deliveries and have become  
27 commonly used and commonly accepted as a reliable means of communication; and

29 WHEREAS, the General Assembly encourages the efficient use of modern  
30 technology by the Bureau of Legislative Research,

32 NOW THEREFORE,

33 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL  
34 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

36 That the Bureau of Legislative Research shall communicate



1 electronically with members of the General Assembly through messages sent to  
2 each member's General Assembly electronic mail address unless the member  
3 provides the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research with a written  
4 request that the member receive communications and notices at a different  
5 electronic mail address or in writing sent through the United States Postal  
6 Service to a specified address.
