4	of the possessive form of the name of our state is "Arkansas's".
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6	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be considered to be
7	supplemental to Concurrent Resolution 4 of 1881, which established the
8 9	correct pronunciation of the name of our state.
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
