8	HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
9	RESOLUTION URGING THE ARKANSAS STATE GAME AND
10	FISH COMMISSION TO CONSIDER ALLOWING OUT-OF-STATE
11	MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD ANY OTHER UNIT
12	OF A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES TO
13	QUALIFY FOR RESIDENT HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES
14	WHILE SERVING IN ARKANSAS IF THE STATE WHICH THE
15	MEMBER IS A RESIDENT RECIPROCATES FOR ARKANSAS
16	GUARDSMEN AND RESERVISTS.

19	RESOLUTION URGING THE ARKANSAS STATE
20	GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO ALLOW OUT-
21	OF-STATE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD
22	AND ANY OTHER UNIT OF A RESERVE
23	COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES TO QUALIFY
24	FOR HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES.

27	WHEREAS, pursuant to Amendment 35 of the Arkansas Constitution, the
28	Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission has the exclusive authority to issue
29	hunting and fishing licenses and permits; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, currently only servicemen and servicewomen permanently
32	stationed or assigned in Arkansas are granted resident privileges for hunting
33	and fishing in Arkansas. Servicemen and servicewomen who are Arkansas
34	residents at the time of entering service are also granted resident
35	privileges for hunting and fishing, regardless of where they are stationed in
36	the United States: and

2	WHEREAS, currently any serviceman or servicewomen who comes to Arkansas
3	as a member of the National Guard or any other unit of a reserve component of
4	the armed forces on temporary assignment is not granted resident privileges
5	for hunting and fishing in Arkansas; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, in recognition of the very valuable service these servicemen
8	and servicewomen provide to the people of this nation, it would be worthy to
9	consider extending resident hunting and fishing privileges to those members
10	of the National Guard or any other unit of a reserve component of the armed
11	forces who are temporarily assigned in this state, even though they are not
12	full-time residents of Arkansas,
13	
14	NOW THEREFORE,
15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL
16	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
17	
18	THAT the members of the House of Representatives and the Senate
19	respectfully request that the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission
20	consider granting resident hunting and fishing licenses privileges to any
21	person who does not permanently reside in Arkansas but who is a member of the
22	National Guard or any other unit of a reserve component of the armed forces
23	of the United States and is temporarily assigned in Arkansas. However, the
24	granting of these privileges should be extended only if the state from which
25	the member is a resident agrees to provide reciprocal privileges for Arkansas
26	servicemen and servicewomen temporarily serving in that state.
