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26 WHEREAS, foundation funding distributed to public school districts
27 throughout Arkansas currently includes a sum for the purpose of funding
28 employer contributions for public school employee health insurance; and
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30 WHEREAS, public school districts and public school employees would
31 benefit from a study of whether funding employer contributions at the
32 district level is the most efficient funding method,
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34 NOW THEREFORE,

35 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL
36 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:



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THAT the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education study the impact of removing school employee health insurance funding from foundation funding and transferring that obligation to the State of Arkansas.

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED that the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education prepare a report detailing the results of the study on or before May 1, 2008.
