18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL
19	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
20	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

22	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
23	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
24	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
25	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
26	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
27	the State of Arkansas, to wit:

29	SECTION 1. Article 7, Section 47 of the Arkansas Constitution is
30	amended to read as follows:
31	47. Constables - Term of office - Certificate of election Office
32	<u>abolished</u> .
33	The qualified electors of each township shall elect the Constable for
34	the term of two years, who shall be furnished, by the presiding Judge of the
35	County Court, with a certificate of election, on which his official oath
36	shall be indersed The office of Constable is abolished.
