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- 3 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution is 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 § 5. Time of meeting Regular and fiscal sessions.
- 6 <u>(a)</u> The General Assembly shall meet at the seat of government every
  7 two years, on the first Tuesday after the second Monday in November, until
  8 said time be altered by law year.
- 9 (b) The General Assembly shall meet in regular session on the second
  10 Monday in January of each odd-numbered year to consider any bill or
  11 resolution. The General Assembly may alter the time at which the regular
  12 session begins.
- 13 (c)(1) Beginning in 2010, the General Assembly shall meet in fiscal

  14 session on the second Monday in February of each even-numbered year to

  15 consider only appropriation bills. The General Assembly may alter the time

  16 at which the fiscal session begins.
- 17 (2) A bill other than an appropriation bill may be considered in
  18 a fiscal session if two-thirds (2/3) of the members of each house of the
  19 General Assembly approve consideration of the bill.
  - (d) The General Assembly, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly, may alter the dates of the regular session and fiscal session so that regular sessions occur in even-numbered years and the fiscal sessions occur in odd-numbered years.

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- SECTION 2. Section 17 of Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution is amended to read as follows:
- § 17. Duration of sessions.
- The regular biennial sessions, shall not exceed sixty days in duration;
  unless by a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house of said
  General Assembly.
- 31 (a) A regular biennial session shall not exceed sixty (60) calendar
  32 days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the
  33 members elected to each house of the General Assembly. The regular biennial
  34 session shall not exceed seventy five (75) calendar days in duration, unless
  35 extended by a vote of three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected to each
  36 house of the General Assembly.

1	(b) A fiscal session shall not exceed thirty (30) calendar days in		
2	duration, except that by a vote of three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected		
3	to each house of the General Assembly a fiscal session may be extended one		
4	(1) time by no more than fifteen (15) calendar days.		
5	(c) Provided, that this section shall not apply <del>to the first session o</del>

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9	SECTION 3. Section 29 of Article 5 of the Constitution of Arkansas is

14	The Commission shall elect an Executive Secretary, whose salary shall
