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30	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL
31	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
32	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
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34	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
35	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
36	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Senators and



1	Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the
2	election, adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the
3	Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:
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5	SECTION 1. Section 38 of Article 5 of the Arkansas Constitution is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	§ 38. Taxes - Increase - Approval by electors.
8	§ 2. None of the rates for property, excise, privilege or personal
9	taxes, now levied shall be increased by the General Assembly except after the
10	approval of the qualified electors voting thereon at an election, or in case
11	of emergency, by the votes of three-fourths of the members elected to each
12	House of the General Assembly. [As added to Art. 5 by Const. Amend. 19.]
13	(a) The General Assembly may enact a law to levy a new tax or to
14	increase the rate of any existing tax only upon the affirmative vote of
15	three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected to each house of the General
16	Assembly.
17	(b) The General Assembly shall not enact a law to decrease the rate of
18	any tax or to provide a tax exemption, credit, exclusion, or deduction except
19	upon the affirmative vote of fifty-one percent (51%) of the members elected
20	to each house of the General Assembly.
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22	SECTION 2. This amendment shall become effective January 1, 2009.
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
