arrest and began to take him into custody, the suspect resisted being taken into custody by pulling a concealed knife and stabbing Officer Roussie in the abdomen during the ensuing struggle; and WHEREAS, after sustaining a stab wound in the abdomen and a deep cut on his thumb, Officer Roussie disarmed the suspect and restrained him until backup units from the police department arrived; and WHEREAS, as a result of his wounds, Officer Roussie underwent successful emergency surgery at the Baptist Medical Center in Little Rock, Arkansas, and is expected to recover completely from his wounds; and WHEREAS, Officer Roussie is eager to resume his duties with the Maumelle Police Department, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY: THAT the House of Representatives commends Officer Gregory Roussie for his valor and bravery in the line of duty and thanks him for his commitment to the protection of the people and property of the City of Maumelle, Arkansas.
