19	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL
20	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21	
22	That House Rule 32 is amended to read as follows:
23	32. <u>(a)</u> Introduction and reading of bills and resolutions may be
24	ordered by the Speaker of the House at his/her discretion.
25	(b) The following types of resolutions shall be considered for
26	passage during the time set aside for the consideration of members' own
27	amendments to their own bills: a memorial resolution, a concurrent memorial
28	resolution, and a resolution or a concurrent resolution that commends,
29	congratulates, or recognizes an individual, group, or other entity.
30	Notwithstanding Rule 25 (h), a concurrent resolution or concurrent memorial
31	resolution that is subject to this rule may be transmitted to the Senate on
32	the same day that it is passed. A joint resolution proposing a
33	Constitutional amendment shall be placed on the regular House calendar and is
34	subject to Rule 25 (h).
