- 19 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a
- 20 severable part of the section. If the requirement of approval by the
- 21 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
- 22 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is
- 23 void.
- 24 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary
- 25 adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for
- 26 the transfer or deposit of the funds and appropriations from each State
- 27 Agency to the appropriation authorized in Section 11 of this Act and to the
- 28 various Arkansas Building Authority accounts to be used exclusively by the
- 29 Arkansas Building Authority for each fiscal year of the 2005-2007 2007-2009
- 30 biennium.
- 31 (c) At the close of the first fiscal year of the biennium any unexpended
- 32 appropriation for the Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation shall
- 33 be carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the second
- 34 fiscal year of the biennium.
- 35 (d) The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 36 2005 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION 3 4 POOL. To address the emerging infrastructure needs of Arkansas state 5 government, the Arkansas Building Authority shall establish and maintain for 6 the 2005-2007 2007-2009 biennium a pool of twenty (20) classified positions, 7 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes. These positions 8 are to be used in the event the Arkansas Building Authority executes one or 9 more building contracts or maintenance agreements with state agencies, and 10 the number and level of positions regularly authorized for the Arkansas 11 Building Authority are not sufficient to address these needs. The Arkansas 12 Building Authority shall provide justification to the Department of Finance 13 and Administration's Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for the need to 14 allocate titles from this position pool. No classifications will be assigned 15 to the pool until such time as specific positions are requested and justified 16 by the Arkansas Building Authority, recommended by OPM and approved by the 17 Arkansas Legislative Council. The Arkansas Building Authority may transfer positions from this pool to any appropriation/pay schedule the agency 18 19 currently maintains or any appropriation/pay schedule the agency receives for the 2005-2007 2007-2009 biennium. If the agency requests continuation of a 20 21 "Growth Pool" position(s) as established herein during the next biennium, the 22 position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial 23 budget request. Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a 24 state agency is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually 25 accomplished by delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying 26 job titles and the maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. 27 General Assembly has determined that the Arkansas Building Authority could 28 be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. 29 That flexibility is being accomplished by providing growth pools as in this 30 section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers 31 under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the 32 General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by 33 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the 34 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative 35 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of 36 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of

1	competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. The provisions of this		
2	section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2005}{2007}$ through June 30, $\frac{2007}{2007}$		
3	<u>2009</u> .

5	SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized		
6	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		
7	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the		
8	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
9	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		
10	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal		
11	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by		
12	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be		
13	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.		
14			
15	SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly		
16	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained		
17	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act		
18	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations		
19	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by		
20	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral		
21	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or		
22	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
23			
24	SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
25	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
26	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the		
27	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of		
28	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
29	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective		
30	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the		
31	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.		
32	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
33	ecessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
34	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
