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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
28 Department of Finance and Administration - Alcoholic Beverage Control
29 Enforcement Division for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number
30 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of
31 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
32 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
33 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
34 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
35 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
36 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular

 2 successor.

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 19 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 20 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 21 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 22 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 29 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 36 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
