25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is ess	ential to the opera	tion of
26	the agency for which the appropriations in this	Act are provided, a	nd that in
27	the event of an extension of the Regular Session	, the delay in the	<u>effective</u>
28	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work	irreparable harm up	on the
29	proper administration and provision of essential	governmental progr	ams.
