OF SALARIES. Salaries as authorized in Section 1 of this Act shall be in
effect from and after January 8, 2007.

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SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 4 5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 10 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

14 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 19 20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 24 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Office of the Governor are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient 25 26 for the Office of the Governor to continue to provide essential governmental 27 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies 28 for the Office of the Governor to continue such services; and that a delay in 29 the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper 30 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 31 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 32 33 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 34 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 35 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 36
