(iii) The term "police officer" shall not include any civilian employee of a police department or any person temporarily employed as a police officer during an emergency. (C)(i) "Firefighter" means any regular employee of a fire department whose primary duty is fire fighting, including probationary firefighters. (ii) "Firefighter" shall not include any civilian employee of a fire department or any person temporarily employed as a firefighter during an emergency. (D)(i) "Public safety member" shall not include a member whose employment as a police officer or firefighter commenced on or after July 1, 1997. (ii)(a) If a public safety member leaves his or her employment as a police officer or firefighter for employment as a police officer or firefighter in a position covered by the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System, State Police Retirement System, or Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System and returns to his or her previous employment as a police officer or firefighter, the public safety member shall resume receiving credited service at one and one-half $(1 \ 1/2)$ times the regular rate for crediting service.
