If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 16 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 17 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 18 19 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009. 20 21 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION - INDUSTRY TRAINING PROGRAM. During either fiscal year of the 23 24 2005-2007 2007-2009 biennium any savings accomplished in line item (02) of 25 the Industry Training Section 10 of this Act, Extra Help, may be transferred 26 to line item (04) of the Industry Training Section 10 of this Act, 27 Maintenance and General Operation after prior review approval by the 28 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 29 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 30 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 31 32 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 33 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 34 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 35 has determined that the Department of Economic Development may operate more 36 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Economic

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1 Development authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 2 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 3 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 4 5 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 6 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 7 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 8 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 10 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009. 11 12 SECTION 34. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 13 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 14 15 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 18 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 21 22 SECTION 35. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 23 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 30 31 SECTION 36. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 34 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 36

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
