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2 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 3 Committee as provided by this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 7 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 8 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 10 through June 30, 2007 2009. 11 12 SECTION 34. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
