22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-285-103 is amended to read as follows:  
25 14-285-103. Collection of annual installments.

26 (a) The county collector of each county wherein is located all or part  
27 of a municipal recreation improvement district formed in a second class city  
28 shall collect the annual installments of the assessment of benefits by the  
29 district and the amount shall be collected along with and at the same time as  
30 ad valorem real property taxes.

31 (b) The county collector shall not accept payment of ad valorem real  
32 property taxes unless accompanied by payment of annual installments of the  
33 assessments by the municipal recreation improvement districts.

34 (c) All municipal recreation improvement districts shall report their  
35 assessments of benefits to the county collectors at such time and in such  
36 manner as required by the county collectors.



1           ~~(d) When the State Land Commissioner collects payment of delinquent~~  
2 ~~annual installments of the assessments, he shall transmit the payment, less a~~  
3 ~~proportionate part of the cost of collection, to the treasurer of the~~  
4 ~~district.~~

5           (d) A municipal recreation improvement district may enforce collection  
6 of a delinquent assessment by a proceeding in the circuit court of the county  
7 in the manner as provided for municipal property owners' improvement  
8 districts under § 14-94-122.
