Funds 33 allocated under the appropriation for community-based services, for Grants to 34 Community Providers, in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-35 Aid appropriation in this act shall be used only to provide services through 36 private community based services licensed or certified by the Arkansas

- 1 Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS). Non-profit community-
- 2 based programs licensed by the Division of Developmental Disabilities

Personnel employed in areas 12 providing critical support and care to Patient Units at the state operated 13 human development centers during evening and night shifts shall be eligible 14 15 to receive up to twenty percent (20%) of the hourly rate paid as a shift 16 differential. Personnel required to provide critical and support care to 17 client units during weekend hours shall be eligible to receive up to twenty percent (20%) of the hourly rate paid as weekend differential. When 18 facilities use shifts other than traditional eight-hour shifts, shift 19 differential may be paid for those shifts exceeding the normal day shift of 20 the facility. 2	SECTION $19.$ COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

6	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

16	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
17	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
18	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
19	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

21	SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
22	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
23	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
24	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
25	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
26	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
27	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
28	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
29	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
30	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
31	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
