6	(3)(A) $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ During the 2006–2007 school year, a $\underline{\text{A}}$ school district with an			
7	average daily membership that is less than the school district's previous			
8	year's average daily membership experiencing declining enrollment shall			
9	receive:			
10	(i) (a) Declining enrollment funding equal to the			
11	difference between the average of the two (2) immediately preceding years'			
12	average daily memberships and the average daily membership for the previous			
13	school year multiplied by five thousand six hundred twenty dollars (\$5,620)			
14	based on the greater of the average daily membership of the previous year or			
15	the average of the average daily membership for the three (3) previous years,
