10 AN ACT TO RECOGNIZE, HONOR, AND PROTECT ARKANSAS
11 CITIZENS WHO ARE SUMMONED TO SERVE AS JURORS IN
12 ARKANSAS STATE COURTS; TO INCREASE THE RATE OF
13 JUROR COMPENSATION; TO REIMBURSE COUNTIES FOR THE
14 COSTS OF JURIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code §§ 16-34-101 and
28 16-34-102 are repealed.

29 ~~16-34-101. Exceptions.~~

30 ~~The provisions of §§ 16-34-102, 16-34-104, and 16-34-105 shall not~~
31 ~~apply to Fulton County and Izard County.~~

33 ~~16-34-102. Compensation and reimbursement generally.~~

34 ~~(a) Jurors' compensation and mileage shall be taxed as cost and paid~~
35 ~~by the unsuccessful party.~~

36 ~~(b) Jurors who leave home and attend any court in pursuance of a~~



1 ~~summons shall be allowed the sum necessarily paid out for crossing any ferry~~
2 ~~or toll bridge in going to and returning from such court.~~

3 ~~(c) The clerk shall give to each petit juror a certificate of his~~
4 ~~attendance and services as such juror.~~

5 ~~(d) Any person who attends any court in this state as a juror in~~
6 ~~obedience to a summons, except people who are summoned among the bystanders~~
7 ~~at the court, and is from any cause not accepted on the jury shall receive~~
8 ~~the same fees for each day's attendance until excused or discharged as are~~
9 ~~allowed jurors in the court.~~

11 SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code § 16-34-103 is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 16-34-103. Per diem fees compensation for jurors and prospective
14 jurors.

15 ~~Persons whose names appear on any legal and authorized grand jury or~~
16 ~~petit jury list of the respective counties of Arkansas shall receive in~~
17 ~~addition to any other fees allowable by law the following per diem fees:~~

18 ~~(1) When the person fails for any reason to attend court, none;~~

19 ~~(2) When the person attends court and is excused by the court~~
20 ~~for any reason from serving as a juror, a minimum of fifteen dollars~~
21 ~~(\$15.00); and~~

22 ~~(3) When the person has been sworn touching his qualifications~~
23 ~~to serve as a juror and has been accepted by the court as qualified, a~~
24 ~~minimum fee of thirty five dollars (\$35.00).~~

25 (a) Any person who receives official notice that he or she has been
26 selected as a prospective juror or who is chosen as a juror is eligible to
27 receive per diem compensation for service if:

28 (1) The person actually appears at the location to which the
29 juror or prospective juror was summoned; and

30 (2) The person's appearance is duly noted by the circuit clerk.

31 (b) The per diem compensation payable to any person who is eligible
32 for payment under subsection (a) of this section is forty dollars (\$40.00)
33 per day.

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35 SECTION 3. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code § 16-34-104 is
36 amended to read as follows:

1 16-34-104. Mileage ~~of unaccepted~~ reimbursement for jurors.

2 Any person who attends any court of record in the State of Arkansas as
 3 a juror in obedience to a summons, except such persons as are summoned among
 4 the bystanders at the court, and who for any cause is not accepted on the
 5 jury is eligible to receive per diem compensation under § 16-34-103 and whose
 6 primary place of residence is outside the city limits of the city where the
 7 court that summoned the juror or prospective juror is located shall receive,
 8 in addition to the per diem compensation, a mileage reimbursement payment for
 9 mileage from and to his or her home by the most direct and practicable route
 10 at a rate to be prescribed by the quorum court of the county, but this rate
 11 ~~is not to exceed~~ the rate prescribed for state employees in state travel
 12 regulations.

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 14 SECTION 4. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code § 16-34-105 is
 15 repealed.

16 ~~16-34-105. Account for mileage.~~

17 ~~Every account for mileage for jurors shall be made out at the same time~~
 18 ~~and in the same manner as their per diem account is now made.~~

 20 SECTION 5. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter
 21 34, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

22 16-34-106. Payment by county - Reimbursement by state.

23 (a) The per diem compensation under § 16-34-103 and the mileage
 24 reimbursement under § 16-34-104 shall be paid promptly to each juror or
 25 prospective juror by a county from funds appropriated for that purpose by the
 26 quorum court.

27 (b)(1) The state shall reimburse a county for costs incurred for a
 28 payment under subsection (a) of this section if the county makes a request
 29 under subdivision (b)(3) of this section.

30 (2) The Administrative Office of the Courts shall administer the
 31 state reimbursement to a county under subdivision (b)(1) of this section.

32 (3) A county may request reimbursement for costs incurred for a
 33 payment under subsection (a) of this section on a quarterly basis as follows:

34 (A) On or before May 1 of each year for costs incurred
 35 between January 1 and March 31 of that year;

36 (B) On or before August 1 of each year for costs incurred

1 between April 1 and June 30 of that year;

2 (C) On or before December 1 of each year for costs
3 incurred between July 1 and September 30 of that year; and

4 (D) On or before February 1 of each year for costs
5 incurred between October 1 and December 31 of the prior year.

6 (4) The Administrative Office of the Courts shall consult with
7 the Division of Legislative Audit and shall prescribe the information that
8 shall be documented and certified by a county in order to receive
9 reimbursement under subdivision (b)(1) of this section.

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
