25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, is amended to add an
28 additional subchapter to read as follows:

29 Subchapter 6 – Textbooks and course materials

30 6-60-601. Customized textbooks and course materials prohibited.

31 (a)(1) As used in this section, "customized textbook or course
32 material" means an undergraduate textbook or course material that contains
33 information that:

34 (A) Includes supplemental information, logos, design
35 features, or any other information specific to the college, university,
36 technical institute, geographic area, or state;
