18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 28-50-101(a), pertaining to the statute of
21 nonclaim for filing claims against an estate, is amended to read as follows:

22 (a) Statute of Nonclaim.

23 (1) Except as provided in §§ 28-50-102 and 28-50-110, all claims
24 against a decedent's estate, other than expenses of administration and claims
25 of the United States which, under valid laws of the United States, are not
26 barrable by a statute of nonclaim, but including claims of a state or
27 territory of the United States and any subdivision thereof, whether due or to
28 become due, absolute or contingent, liquidated or unliquidated, founded on
29 contract or otherwise, shall be forever barred as against the estate, the
30 personal representative, or the heirs and devisees of the decedent, unless
31 *verified to the personal representative or filed with the court within ~~three~~*
32 *~~(3) months~~ six (6) months after the date of the first publication of notice*
33 *to creditors.*

34 (2) ~~However,~~ All claims for injury or death caused by the
35 negligence of the decedent shall also be filed within *six (6) months* from the
36 date of first publication of the notice, or they shall be forever barred and



1 precluded from any benefit in the estate.
