SECTION 57. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUFFALO
- 2 GNAT CONTROL PROGRAM. The Appropriation authorized for the Buffalo Gnat
- 3 Control Program in Item (09) of Section 3 of this Act, shall be expended only
- 4 for the control of buffalo gnats in the Arkansas counties of Miller,
- 5 LaFayette, Little River and parts of Hempstead.
- 6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005

- 26 PROVISION PEST ERADICATION. During either fiscal year of the 2005-2007
- 27 2007-2009 Biennium, if the State Plant Board determines that the demands of
- 28 pest eradication efforts require additional personnel expenses, with the
- 29 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and review approval by the
- 30 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, appropriations may be
- 31 transferred from the Pest Eradication Program special line item to the line
- 32 items for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Overtime, and Personal Services
- 33 Matching.
- 34 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

- 19 HELP PROVISION. No employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who is
- 20 employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed 3/4 of the maximum
- 21 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-
- 22 201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor may such employee be employed for a
- 23 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year.

- 35 PROVISION. During either fiscal year of the 2005-2007 2007-2009 biennium, if
- 36 the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary firefighters,

- l dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a wildfire season,
- 2 and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, appropriations
- 3 may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees and Services
- 4 to the proper character code for the employment of such personnel.
- 5 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air
- 6 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and

- 22 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees

5	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
12	
13	SECTION 67. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
20	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
