21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
24 the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Operations for the 2007-2009 biennium,  
25 the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
26 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
27 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
28 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
29 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
30 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
31 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
32 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
33 101), or its successor.

 24 EXPENSES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture

 26 fund or fund accounts, the following:

27 (A) For equipment upgrades and operating expenses of the Aquaculture

7 GNAT CONTROL PROGRAM. The Appropriation authorized for the Buffalo Gnat  
8 Control Program in Item (09) of Section 3 of this Act, shall be expended only  
9 for the control of buffalo gnats in the Arkansas counties of Miller,  
10 LaFayette, Little River and parts of Hempstead.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~

14 SECTION 64. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

16 REIMBURSEMENT. Funds appropriated in Item (07), (08) and (09) of Section 20

30 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation provided in the Brucellosis  
31 Control and Eradication Program, which remains at the close of the fiscal  
32 year ending June 30, ~~2006~~ 2008, shall be carried forward and made available  
33 for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

30 TRANSFER. The Executive Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission,  
31 with prior ~~review~~ approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint  
32 Budget Committee, the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and  
33 for the reimbursing of documented expenditures designated by law to be made  
34 from the transferred special revenue, may transfer funds among the Livestock  
35 and Poultry Equine Infectious Anemia Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry  
36 Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Special

32 PROVISION - PEST ERADICATION. During either fiscal year of the 2005-2007  
33 2007-2009 Biennium, if the State Plant Board determines that the demands of  
34 pest eradication efforts require additional personnel expenses, with the  
35 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and ~~review~~ approval by the  
36 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, appropriations may be

1 transferred from the Pest Eradication Program special line item to the line  
2 items for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Overtime, and Personal Services  
3 Matching.

4 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
5 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
6 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by  
7 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

23 SECTION 68. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
25 HELP PROVISION. No employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who is  
26 employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed 3/4 of the maximum  
27 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-  
28 201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor may such employee be employed for a  
29 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year.  
30 Provided, however, that no employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who  
31 is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy five  
32 percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as  
33 authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor  
34 shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fourteen  
35 hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal year.

3 SECTION 69. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
5 PROVISION. During either fiscal year of the ~~2005-2007~~ 2007-2009 biennium, if  
6 the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary firefighters,  
7 dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a wildfire season,  
8 and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, appropriations  
9 may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees and Services  
10 to the proper character code for the employment of such personnel.  
11 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air  
12 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and  
13 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,

20 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation  
21 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in Section 3  
22 and 47.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~

26 SECTION 70. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO  
28 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees  
29 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for  
30 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be  
31 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to  
32 expenditure.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007  
34 through June 30, 2009.

36 SECTION 71. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
2 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. For the biennium ending June 30, 2009, the  
3 Secretary of the Arkansas Department of Agriculture shall at no time  
4 designate general revenue allocations to the State Plant Board, the Arkansas  
5 Livestock and Poultry Commission and the Arkansas Forestry Commission at a  
6 level less than the revenue distribution provided in the Official Forecast of  
7 state general revenue in effect on June 30, 2007 for each of those agencies.

8  
9 SECTION 72. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
12 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18  
19 SECTION 73. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27  
28 SECTION 74. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
34 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
36 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
