36	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		

1	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that textbooks and course materials		
2	for state-supported institution of higher education students are often		
3	purchased at higher prices than necessary or not at all due to a lack of		
4	competitive advertising; that students sometimes do not purchase needed		
5	textbooks and course materials due to a lack of funds; and that the passage		
6	of this act is immediately necessary to enable students to obtain the		
7	textbooks and course materials needed to help ensure a quality education at a		
8	more affordable price. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this		
9	act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
10	health, and safety shall become effective on:		
11	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
12	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
13	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
14	bill; or		
15	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
16	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
