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7	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
8	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Department of Arkansas
9	State Police is experiencing severe revenue shortages that are affecting its
10	fleet operations; that these shortages have hampered its ability to repair
11	automobiles and replace worn out automobiles and purchase vehicle equipment;
12	and that this act is immediately necessary because it provides some much
13	needed additional moneys to the Department of Arkansas State Police and
14	should be given immediate effect. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
15	exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
16	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
