20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-23-128 is amended to read as follows:
23 27-23-128. Deferment of sentence - Restrictions.

24 No circuit or district court judge may utilize the provisions of §§ 5-
25 4-311, 5-4-321, 16-90-115, or 16-93-301 - 16-93-303[pcc100] or any other
26 program to defer imposition of sentence in instances in which the defendant
27 holds a commercial driver license and is charged with violating any state or
28 local traffic law while operating a commercial motor vehicle as defined by §
29 27-23-103(7) other than a parking violation.
