32	(1) A special motorcycle event sponsored by a city, county,

6	As used in this subchapter:		
7	(1) "Motorcycle owners' organization" means an entity that is		
8	organized as a nonprofit entity or for-profit entity and in good standing

10	(2) "Nonprofit entity" means an entity that has received tax		
11	exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to section 501(c)(3)		
12	or section (501)(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as it existed on		
13	January 1, 2007;		
14	(3) "Public venue" means a location that:		
15	(A) Is open to the general public; and		
16	(B) Is not the address designated as the primary business

8	(a) If the statement of estimated positive economic impact that is		
9	submitted to the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission establishes that a special		
10	motorcycle event has a significant positive economic impact, the special		
11	motorcycle event is exempt from regulation by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle		
12	Commission as provided under § 23-112-805.		
13	(b) If the statement of estimated positive economic impact that is		
14	presented to the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission establishes that a special		
15	motorcycle event will not have a significant positive economic impact, then		
16	the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission shall determine whether the special		
17	motorcycle event is exempt from the provisions of this chapter and any rules		
18	promulgated by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission.

20	23-112-805. Authority to waive relevant market area and rules.		
21	(a) The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission shall waive the following		
22	for a special motorcycle event that has a significant positive economic		
23	impact or is determined by the commission to otherwise qualify for an		
24	exemption under § 23-112-804(b) if no franchised motor vehicle dealer of a		
25	licensed manufacturer is represented in the host county of the special		
26	motorcycle event or the counties contiguous to the host county:		
27	(1) The provisions of this chapter regarding relevant market		
28	area; and		
29	(2) The rules regarding motor vehicle dealers in contiguous		
30	counties.		
31	(b)(1) The commission may promulgate rules for the issuance of a		
32	temporary permit to out-of-state motor vehicle dealers and manufacturers to		
33	participate in a special motorcycle event under this subchapter.		
34	(2) No rule shall be promulgated that puts a greater burden on

14	(a) A special motorcycle event that has been ongoing for five (5)		
15	years or more before the effective date of this act and has had a significant		
16	positive economic impact in the past shall be:		
17	(1) Considered an established and ongoing special motorcycle		
18	event; and		
19	(2) Eligible to a presumption of a significant positive economic		
20	impact by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission.		
21	(b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, an		
22	established and ongoing special motorcycle event under this section may		
23	continue to invite motor vehicle dealers and manufacturers that have		
24	participated in the special motorcycle event for the previous three (3)

27	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-112-312 is amended to read as follows:		
28	23-112-312. License reciprocity with other states.		
29	(a) The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission is authorized to <u>may</u> enter		
30	into reciprocal agreements with motor vehicle commissions, or their		
31	equivalents, in other states to allow motor vehicle dealers who are licensed		
32	in those states to obtain a temporary permit in this state, pursuant to the		
33	rules and regulations promulgated by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission.		
34	(b) Any person who is licensed under the laws of another state or		
35	territory of the United States to engage in business as a motor vehicle		
36	dealer may apply for a temporary permit in this state upon production of		

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satisfactory proof that: (1) The other state or territory grants similar reciprocity to license holders of this state; (2) The requirements for licensing in the particular state or territory were, at the date of the applicant's licensing, substantially equivalent to the requirements in effect in this state at the date of the applicant's licensing; (3)(2) The applicant meets all the qualifications for the temporary permit and pays the fees specified for the permits pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission; and (4)(3) The applicant meets other reasonable qualifications as may be adopted by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission for reciprocity.
