25	(a) There is created th	e Arkansas Legislative	Task Force on Abused and

27	(b) The task force shal	l consist of the follow	ring members:
28	(1) The Governor	or the Governor's desig	nee;

- 9 (23) Chief Counsel of the Department of Health and Human

- 13 (c)(1) The Chair of the Senate Interim Committee on Children and Youth
- or the chair's designee shall call the first meeting within thirty (30)
- 15 <u>ninety (90)</u> days of August 12, 2005 the adjournment of the regular session of
- 16 the General Assembly and shall serve as chair at the first meeting.
- 17 (2) At the first meeting, the members of the task force shall
- 18 elect from its membership a chair and other officers as needed for the
- 19 transaction of its business.
- 20 (3)(A) The task force shall conduct its meetings in Pulaski
- 21 County at the State Capitol unless the chair designates another location in
- 22 the state that furthers the business of the task force.
- 23 (B) Meetings shall be held at least one (1) time every
- 24 three (3) months, but may occur more often at the call of the chair.
- 25 (d) If any vacancy occurs on the task force, the vacancy shall be
- 26 filled by the same process as the original appointment.
- 27 (e) The task force shall establish rules and procedures for conducting
- 28 its business.
- 29 (f)(1) Members Nonlegislator members of the task force shall serve
- 30 without compensation, but may receive expense reimbursement according to §
- 31 25-16-902 to the extent that funds are appropriated for that purpose.
- 32 (2) Legislator members shall be entitled to reimbursement for
- 33 per diem and mileage at the same rate and from the same source as provided by
- 34 law for members of the General Assembly attending meetings of interim
- 35 committees.
- 36 (3) The task force shall be allowed study expenses for the

1	calling of expert witnesses to testify and related expenses allowed under §		
2	10-3-215 to be paid by the Bureau of Legislative Research from the		
3	appropriation for interim task force study expenses or other available funds.		
4	(g) A majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a		
5	quorum for transacting any business of the task force.		
6	(h) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for the		
7	task force.		
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
