## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-23-108(b) TO WAIVE THE COMMERICAL DRIVER'S LICENSE SKILLS TEST FOR QUALIFIED DRIVERS OF MILITARY VEHICLES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO WAIVE THE COMMERICAL DRIVER'S LICENSE SKILLS TEST FOR TRANSFERRED MILITARY
LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION l. Arkansas Code § 27-23-108(b), concerning the waiver of the commercial driver's license skills test, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(l) Waiver of Skills Test. The Department of Arkansas State Police may waive the skills test specified in this section for a commercial driver driver's license applicant who meets the requirements of 49 C.F.R., part 383.77 .
(2)(A) For purposes of this subdivision (b)(2), "valid military commercial driver's license" shall mean any commercial driver's license that is recognized by any active or reserve component of any branch or unit of the United States armed forces as currently being valid or as having been valid at the time of the applicant's separation or discharge from the military that occurred within the twelve-month period prior to the date of application to the Office of Driver Services for a commercial driver's license.
(B) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall waive the skills test specified in this section for any commercial driver's license
applicant who:
(i) Possesses a valid military commercial driver's

1icense; and
(ii) Signs the application for a commercial driver's
license certifying that the applicant's driving privileges have not been
suspended, revoked, or canceled and that the applicant has not had a
conviction for any disqualifying offense as described in § 27-23-112.
(C) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall:
(i) Indicate on the application for a commercial
driver's license the class of license and any endorsements for which the applicant has successfully completed the knowledge requirements; and
(ii) Return the application for a commercial
driver's license, along with the military commercial driver's license, to the Office of Driver Services for the issuance of the commercial driver's license.
