SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code Annotated 26-58-124
(b)(2)(A)(ii), concerning the Distribution of severance tax, is hereby
amended:

14 (a) The next three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) or so much 15 thereof as may be collected in severance taxes, penalties, and costs on 16 timber and timber products, over and above the amount distributed to the 17 State Forestry Fund during each fiscal year as provided in subdivision (b)(2)(A)(i) of this section, shall be distributed and credited to the 18 19 University of Arkansas at Monticello Fund. SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 29 BALANCES.
