15 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DECLARED 17 EMERGENCY - TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS. 11 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.
