1 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DECLARED 3 4 EMERGENCY - TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS. At any time when the Governor of the 5 State of Arkansas declares that an emergency exists, and the Southern 6 Arkansas University-Tech, Fire Training Academy is required to lend 7 assistance, the Southern Arkansas University-Tech, Fire Training Academy will 8 be authorized to make transfers of appropriation, either General Revenue or 9 Cash, and further, that no such transfer will increase the total amount 10 appropriated for the Southern Arkansas University-Tech, Fire Training 11 Academy. 12 Any use of this authorization shall be reported to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee within 90 days of the date of the transfer. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 14 15 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 16 17 SECTION 14.
