24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND THE ARKANSAS
27 ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY. There is hereby established for the University of
28 Arkansas - Various Divisions and the Archeological Survey for the 2007-2009
29 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
30 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
31 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and
32 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
33 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
34 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
35 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
36 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas

21 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER
 23 GRANT RELATED FUNDING PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics and
 24 Sciences and the Arts who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract
 25 requirements also write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish
 26 papers may be authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to
 27 ~~1/12~~ 1/10 of their annual salary. Such additional compensation shall not be

13 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged

7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

12 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
