22 Using successive Arkansas Department of Labor Prevailing Wage 23 Determination (ADLPWD) Building Rates for Washington County for the craft 24 title matching that Apprentice's craft training, individual Apprentices shall 25 be paid progressively increasing wages upon successful completion of 26 successive years of training for their craft. Progressively increasing, as 27 strongly encouraged for this type program by the U.S. Department of Labor, is 28 defined as a percentage difference between the Apprentice's current salary 29 and the next year's ADLPWD Washington County Building Rates Basic Hourly Rate 30 for their chosen craft, but not less than the preceding year's wages with any authorized cost of living (COLA) applied. 31

7 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER 9 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees of School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts 10 who, in addition to working during the regular school term also work during 11 the summer months, shall be authorized as additional compensation an amount 12 not to exceed $\frac{1}{12}$ 1/10 of their annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the 13 14 maximum salary authorized for said employees. Payment of additional 15 compensation shall be limited to employees in the following classifications

27 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER 29 GRANT RELATED FUNDING PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics and 30 Sciences and the Arts who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements also write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish 31 32 papers may be authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 33 $\frac{1}{12}$ 1/10 of their annual salary. 34 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 35 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 36 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

9 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 25 26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 29 30 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 31 32 33 34
